

Alder Tree

Alder trees are a native British tree that like to grow near water. It was used for coppicing. In Ireland you could be punished for cutting an Alder as they said they bled red.



- The catkins produced by the Alder tree provide an early source of pollen and nectar for bees and other early pollinators.
- Tap the catkins in early spring to see the pollen get carried away on the lightest of breezes
- One of our smaller native trees
- Catkins (male parts) and Cones (female parts)
- Can grow up to 30m high
- Likes to grow near water
- Alder is the only British native deciduous tree to develop cones with seeds in
