

Broom

An introduction to my favourite plant Broom



- Brooms Latin name is Cytisus scoparius
- Flowers in May, June and July with yellow flowers
- Broomielaw was the site of the 1st jetty built on the Clyde in 1662, the area was a grassy meadow with plenty of broom bushes, hence the name
- It is the County flower of Glasgow
- The branches were used to make brushes/brooms
- Its seed pods are green when they 1st grow and turn black as they dry out
- During the summer, the seed pods dry out and 'explode' with a cracking sound
- Seeds contain toxic chemicals which can affect your heart and nervous system
