

## How to fix a puncture

Getting out on your bike is a great form of exercise and is environmentally friendly too! Do you know how to fix a puncture if your bike is out of action? With some basic, affordable tools and a bit of know how it is easy!

**Step by step process:** 

- 1. Remove the wheel from your bike
- 2. Remove tyre & innertube from wheel
- 3. Locate puncture & identify cause
- 4. Carefully remove any sharps from tvre
- 5. Lightly sand area around the hole
- 6. Apply a thin layer of rubber glue to tube & patch
- 7. When glue is 'tacky' apply patch to puncture & firmly squeeze flat
- 8. Once dry, re-inflate tube to check repair
- 9. Locate tube back in tyre on wheel
- 10.Inflate tyre to recommended pressure (see tyre side wall)
