Key Facts:

- Underneath planet earth's crust are tectonic plates, which collided to form mountain ranges!
- This one runs diagonally across Scotland. From the Isle of Arran in the West to Stonehaven in the East.
- All this happened approximately 400 million years ago
- Sedimentary rocks can be found here....If you're lucky maybe a fossil.
- You can even get, albeit very small... earthquakes!
