## Cons

- Invasive it blocks sunlight and restricts water to other plants therefore inhibiting their growth.
- Prolific seed spreader as it grows to about 2m tall each year, the seeds are easily distributed by the wind.
- Strong while growing, the plant is strong enough to disturb foundations and emerge through rock.

## Pros

- Edible The young shoots have a taste not dissimilar to rhubarb.
- Ornamental plant Beautiful stem, flowers and foliage
