

The Haggis

One of the most elusive Scottish animals, the Haggis hides on the steep slopes of the mountainous Highlands. The Haggis rarely ventures out of their burrows except to feed making them extremely hard to catch.



- 1. Only found wild in Scotland
- 2. Four legs (with one sides legs being longer than the other) allowing fast and nimble movement on the steep ground. Although they are unidirectional, born able to run in one direction around the hills. Clockwise or anticlockwise.
- 3. Short hunting season running from St Andrews Day (30th November) to Burns Day (25th of January)
